The russian war in Ukraine caused many psychological problems among Ukrainian civilians, refugees and its military forces.



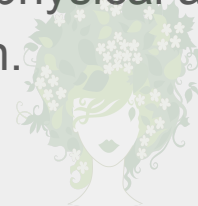
In the post-Soviet territory, the legacy of the consequences of violence in the Second World War and the post-war period of repression is still felt fresh: there was a lot of violence, rape, and torture, but most of the information was hidden, crimes were not recorded, activists were condemned and persecuted.

Therefore, persistent stereotypes were formed in society: **ignoring the facts of war crime, condemning victims, stigmatizing and shielding them.**

- I am a Doctor of Medicine who treats, both physically and psychologically, wounded soldiers, civilians and recently released Ukrainian POWs;
- I help forced migrants in new place with social, medical, psychological assistance;
- I assist victims of violence to restore their physical and mental health.

Functions of the service:

Medical and social assistance to the wounded and their relatives.

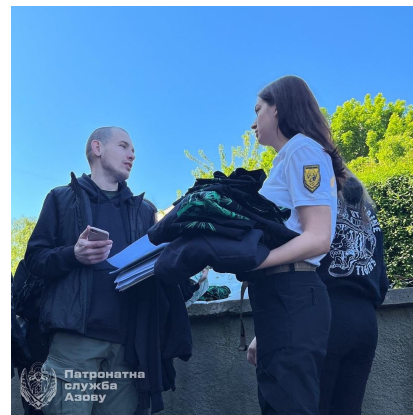
Objective:

- Rehabilitation
- Finding employment for veterans
- Assisting with dignified burial of the perished
- Providing help to relatives of the perished (wives, parents, children, unborn children)
- Providing care for recently released Ukrainian POWs and their relatives
- Providing the best medical, social, and psychological help with fulfillment of all bureaucratic procedures for recently released Ukrainian POWs
- Constant support

Results

Motivated and confident in their future and the future of their families, former soldiers **perform their work well, quickly rehabilitate, and help others.**

Understanding the future comprehensive support for a soldier who goes to fight (may die, be maimed, get captured) motivates them to perform his work, helps to recover faster from injuries, survive capture and its consequences.

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The First Voluntary Surgical Hospital

The private clinic with the European standard was repurposed as **a hospital for military and civilians in 2022**. It started with volunteer doctors from all over the country worked there. Currently it receives partial grant funding.

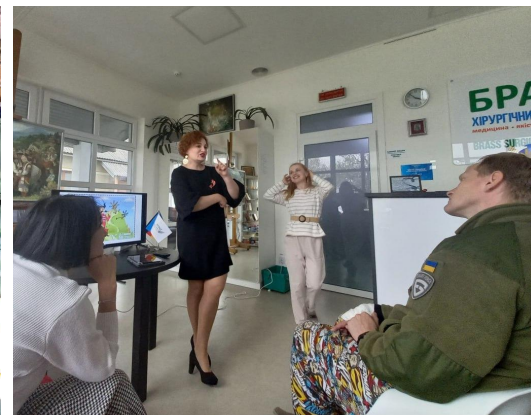
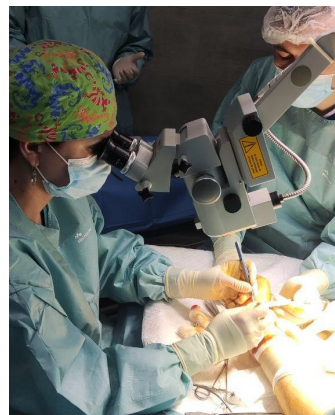
Objective:

- Reconstructive operative treatment.
- Physical rehabilitation.
- Psychological and social rehabilitation by creating comfortable "home" conditions for stay:

good meals, excursions, concerts, exhibitions, plays, movies, etc.

Results

Fast and high-quality recovery of wounded soldiers, full socialization, appreciation of peaceful life, desire to protect it.

Main areas of work:

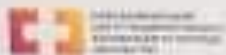
- Providing help to SURVIVORS.
