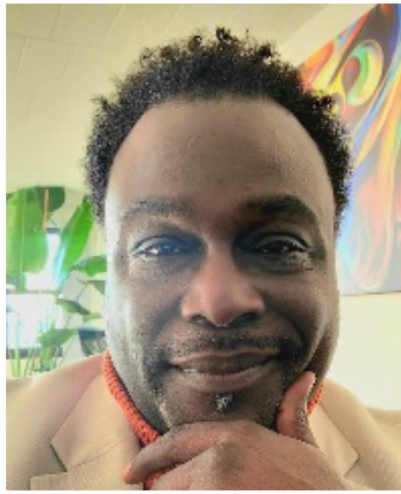


Vadym Farber, Repairer Excellence Award
