# Women

We are 51% of the population, yet 60% of people living in poverty, and 83% of mothers who are the primary caregivers at home.

We do 66% of the work, produce 50% of the food, but earn only 11% of the income and own just 20% of the land.

## 3 out of 3 Law

- The “3 out of 3 Law” against violence is a constitutional reform in Mexico that prevents individuals convicted of sexual offenses, domestic violence, or those who are delinquent child support debtors from holding public office or running for elected positions. This initiative seeks to strengthen ethics in politics and ensure that those who have committed these acts do not have access to governmental roles.

# 3 out of 3 Law

- The “3 out of 3 Law” against violence establishes that individuals with a court-issued conviction for:
  1. Crimes against life and bodily integrity.
  2. Crimes against sexual freedom and security, and the normal psychosexual development.
  3. Domestic, equivalent, or family violence, and violations of sexual privacy.
  4. Political violence against women based on gender.
  5. Being officially declared a delinquent child support debtor.


## 3 out of 3 Law

- Shall not exercise their civic rights or prerogatives, which includes being ineligible to register as candidates for elected positions or to be appointed to jobs, positions, or commissions in public service. This law represents a significant step forward in protecting the rights of women and children, promoting a society free of violence, and ensuring that those who have committed these crimes do not occupy positions of power in government.


## 3 out of 3 Law

- This law impacts family systems and helps prevent the harm caused by Continuous Trauma—due to its prolonged nature—and Complex Trauma, given the multiple interconnected contexts affected by delinquent child support debtors in family life.
- Single-mother households will be supported and recognized in their dignity, as the recovery of victims also depends on a social and justice context that no longer overlooks harm against children and women, allowing for true reparation.

(Porcentaje)**




Prevalence of violence against women aged 15 and older in the school environment in the last 12 months, by survey year (percentage)

**Authorities in Guerrero have documented the existence of the sale of women and girls in the municipalities of Metlatónoc, Cochoapa el Grande, Xochistlahuaca, Igualapa, Tlacoachistlahuaca, and Malinaltepec.**

- Organizations call for an end to the sale of girls in Guerrero. The organizations believe that efforts should focus on aligning a vision of respect for human rights with the autonomy of Indigenous peoples, while eradicating trafficking.

- Non-governmental organizations called on federal and state authorities to immediately implement actions to prevent the “sale” of girls in the Montaña region of Guerrero. In a public statement, the Executive Secretariats of the Child and Adolescent Protection Systems from nearly every state in the country, as well as various civil society organizations, warned that they cannot remain passive in the face of this “intolerable practice,” which constitutes a severe violation of the human rights of the girls who suffer it.






Exchanging girls for goods and animals is NOT a tradition or custom. It is called CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE.
