For dedicating a lifetime of global leadership to safeguard Women's Rights, dignity, and pivotal positions for building sustainable peace, security, and development for generations to come.

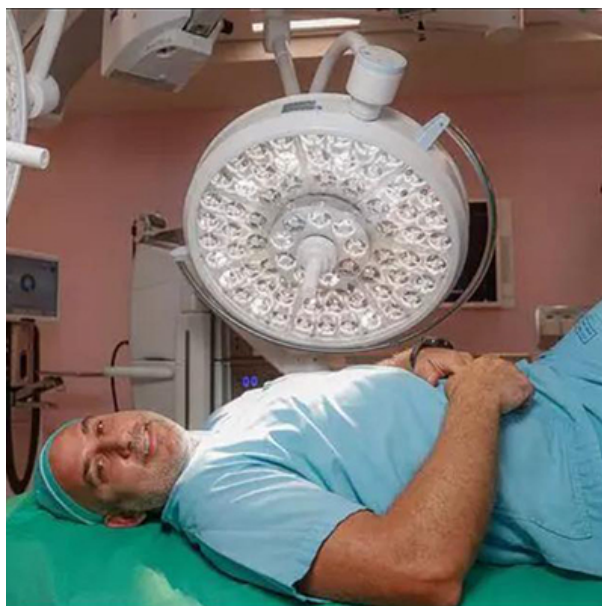
